

3.5 Lid swellings

Lid swellings are discussed in module 4 and module 7.

Lid swellings causing red eye are

- Sty (module 4)
- Chalazion (module 4)
- Preseptal cellulitis (module 4)
- Dacryocystitis (module 7)

Swellings / Lumps Lid	
1. Localized Lid swellings	
Nodules	Chalazion, Sty, Int Hordeolum, Xanthelesma, Mollouscum
Cysts	Cyst of Moll, Cyst of zeiss, Sebacious cyst
Benign tumours	Viral wart, Seborrhoeic keratosis, Actinic keratosis, Naevi, Capillary hemangioma
Malignant tumours	Basal cell carcinoma, Squamous cell crcinoma, Meibomian cell cacinoma, Malignant melanoma
2. Lid margin swellings	
Blepharitis	Anterior Blepharitis (Infective & non-infective) and Posterior Blepharitis (Meibomianitis)
3. Diffuse Lid swellings	
Allergic	Acute allergic edema, Contact dermatitis
Infectious	Preseptal cellulitis, Herpes simplex, Herpes zoster
In systemic diseases	Renal disease, Congestive cardiac failure, Myoedema
